

Privacy Statement

Giuseppe Soligno, administrator of the website www.interfaceequilibrator.com, is responsible for the processing of personal data and has created this Privacy Statement to comply with the prevailing data protection laws.

Personal data that we process

We process your personal data because you provide them to us yourself.

Below you will find an overview of the personal data that we process and how we collect them.

Personal data	How the data is collected
First and/or last name	You provide these to us when submitting the “contact form” or “order form” on our website.
Email address	You provide this to us when submitting the “contact form” or “order form” on our website.
Address details	You provide these to us when submitting the “order form” on our website.
Organization	You provide this to us when submitting the “order form” on our website.
ID number that the Interface Equilibrator software, when launched on a computer, assigns to that computer	You provide this to us when submitting the “order form” on our website (such an ID is based on some computer’s hardware components that are retrieved by the Interface Equilibrator software, when launched on a computer, using standard APIs of the Microsoft Windows® operating system).
License type	You provide these to us when submitting the “order form” on our website.

For what purpose and on what basis do we process personal data

We process your personal data for enabling and disabling the available features of the Interface Equilibrator software that you have requested for a certain computer and for a certain period of time.

How long we store personal data

We do not store your personal data for longer than strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

Sharing personal data with third parties

We do not sell your data to third parties and only provide it if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We conclude a processing agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. We remain responsible for these processes.

View, modify or delete your data

You have the right to view, correct, or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent for the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by us and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we have about you in a computer file to you or another organization named by you. You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to us by using the “contact form” on our

website or by replying to any email that we have sent you after you provided such data to us. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but, in any case, within 30 days. To ensure that the request has been made by you, we will ask you to send us a copy of your ID document.

We remark that any service that you obtained from us may cease to work after your data is modified or deleted.

How we protect personal data

We take the protection of your data seriously and we take appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure, and unauthorized modification.

Cookies and similar techniques

We do not use cookies or similar techniques. Third-party components (videos) embedded in our website may use only essential cookies for the correct display of the video, see next section.

Embedded videos

Our legitimate interest for embedding these components is the smooth integration of the videos in our website and the attractive design of our website. - The embedded components from Vimeo are embedded in our website using Vimeo’s “do not track” URL parameter activated (that is, `dnt=1` is used in the URL of the embedded component). By doing this, we prevent the use of views of embedded YouTube content from influencing the viewer’s browsing experience on YouTube.
